Girls Unite Gala Terms and Conditions

All registrations for Girls Unite Gala are bound by the following terms and conditions.

1.1 General Terms

By enrolling your child, you agree as the parent/guardian to these terms and conditions, agree that your child is bound by the terms and conditions and, where appropriate, will ensure your child is aware of these terms and conditions.

Australian Professional Leagues Company Pty Ltd as trustee for the Australian Professional Leagues Trust (A-Leagues) reserves the right to change any of the Girls Unite Gala details including locations, dates and starting or finishing times at any point in time (where reasonably required). In addition, the event is subject to cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances. This may include unsuitable weather conditions, inadequate registration numbers or other factors that may arise outside the direct control of the A-Leagues. The A-Leagues will not be liable to you for any Loss (as described below) you suffer as a result of the event, or a part of the event, being cancelled, postponed or changed due to reasons outside of the reasonable direct control of the A-Leagues.

A-Leagues in its absolute discretion reserves the right to not accept a registration for the Girls Unite Gala.

1.2 Event Details

1.2.1 Event Details

Dates: Day 1 - Friday, January 12 and Day 2 - Saturday, January 13, 2024

Location: Leichhardt Oval #2, Glover St, Lilyfield NSW 2040

Times: 9:00 - 15:00 each day. Registration is from 8:30am.

Age groups: 6 years to 12 years old

Registration fee: \$80 per day. The registration fees cover the following expenses: coaches and staff, venue hire, equipment, event costs and administration costs.

1.2.2 Registration

Each participant will need to report to the registration desk on arrival. The parent/guardian needs to sign in the participant when on site. Each parent/guardian needs to indicate at time of drop-off if there are alternate arrangements for the collection of the child at the end of the gala day. All parents/guardians will need to sign out their child at the conclusion of the gala day. The gala will conclude at 15:00 each day and parents are required to collect their child by 15:30 at the latest.

1.2.3 Event Inclusions

As part of the registration to Girls Unite Gala, the registration includes access to attend the gala for the registered time (one day) as well as:

- one (1) complimentary pass to the Liberty A-League Women's double header at Leichhardt Oval on the same day as the Girls Unite Gala*. The pass is only valid for the player

(participant) that registered and takes part in the Girls Unite Gala Day. The pass is non-transferrable or for part refunds and is subject to third party terms and conditions (such as ticket terms of entry)

- *For avoidance of doubt, the follow ticket invitations are inline with Girls Unite Gala registrations:

1.3 Venue and Equipment

Registrants must follow all directions from A-Leagues coaches, staff and other official representatives in relation to treatment of clinic venue(s) property and equipment. A-Leagues will not be liable for any matters related to damage to clinic venue, property and equipment and will pass on, and parents / guardians agree that they are liable for, any A-Leagues incurred costs as a result of damage caused by their child.

1.4 Cancellations and refunds

1.4.1 Cancellation of the event

In the event of force majeure or other unforeseen circumstance, the event will not be rescheduled and as such, event organisers will refund all individual player registrations, minus an administration fee of \$10.00. Refunds will be provided back to the original card used at time of registration. Refunds may take up to 30 days.

The event organisers will follow the A-Leagues Lightning and Extreme Weather Protocols. Refer to the event page for more information.

1.4.2 Refund Policy

Subject at all times to relevant provisions of the Australian Consumer Law:

- A full refund will be provided up until Friday, January 5 (with the exception of a \$10.00 administration fee); and
- refunds after this date will be at the discretion of event organisers.

If, after the January 5 cut-off date, a participant is unable to attend the event due to illness, injury or a death in the family, the player's parent/guardian can request a refund for their individual registration fee.

All refund requests must be made to the event organisers via unite.grassroots@aleagues.com.au. Supporting documentation such as a medical certificate is required to be provided with the request.

1.5 Medical

All relevant medical information must be shared when registering for the event. If your child requires medication throughout the day, event organisers will be in contact with you prior to the event and a medical plan is required to be sent through no later than close of business Thursday, January 11. Except in the case of, or to prevent, a medical emergency or unless otherwise agreed between event staff and you, event staff will not administer medication to or for participants.

You grant the event staff permission to take your child to a hospital, administer first aid or call for an ambulance in the event of any illness or injury during the event. You agree to inform us of any health concerns including allergies, injuries or illnesses to your child that we should be aware of prior to your child participating in the event.

1.6 Privacy

You acknowledge that the A-Leagues will collect, retain and disclose personal information submitted to it by you in accordance with Australian privacy laws and its [Privacy Policy](#). The A-Leagues may use, retain or disclose this information for, among other things, the purpose of:

- a. administering the event;
- b. contacting you with A-Leagues related information and promotions (unless or until you let us know otherwise); and
- c. marketing offers and member-related promotions of the A-Leagues, our Partners (as defined in the Privacy Policy) and other parties (unless or until you let us know otherwise).

You acknowledge that the A-Leagues may share your personal information with the Destination NSW, the partner of the event. The A-Leagues may also share your information with ticket and event venue providers, which may include the sharing of health information with event and venue providers so necessary facilities and equipment are provided and to assist with the safe delivery of the event.

In addition to the above, A-Leagues will collect the email address of the primary contact of each parent or guardian and use this as a primary method to communicate key information prior to and after the clinic. Given the operational nature of these communications, these communications cannot be opted out of, but they will cease no later than 1 week after the end of the selected clinic.

1.7 Use of Images/Media

A-Leagues advises that audio recording, photographic and film images of participants at Girls Unite Gala may be used for the purpose of promotion and marketing of the A-Leagues and future programs. If you do not wish for recordings, images or footage of the participant to be used, you must notify the A-Leagues in writing via unite.grassroots@aleagues.com.au.

You acknowledge and agree that media may be present at the event and you consent to A-Leagues media using, reproducing and/or publishing your child's name and/or team's name or image.

By accepting these terms, you agree that copyright and all associated rights in these images/video is owned by the A-Leagues or its licensors and we may make, reproduce, broadcast, stream, use, sell, license or otherwise deal (on a worldwide basis) in any visual or audio recordings of you or your child in any media, worldwide and for any purpose, without the need for your approval or payment of any compensation.

1.8 Copyright

In addition to the above, you acknowledge and agree that copyright and all associated rights of any image and film arising from the event is owned by the A-Leagues or the relevant media source.

1.9 Liability of Injury & Sickness

The A-Leagues will take reasonable steps to safeguard the welfare of all participants in the event. However, you understand that there are inherent risks associated with participation in football games and clinics and you, on your own and your child's behalf, fully accept and agree to bear those risks as they relate to the event that your child is participating in, especially in the case where no shin-pads are being used.

You agree that by registering and participating in Girls Unite Gala, that you, on your child's behalf, have voluntarily accepted the risks of physical injury or sickness, including serious injury such as permanent disability, paralysis or even death. You acknowledge that by voluntarily participating in the Girls Unite Gala with knowledge of the potential dangers and/or risks involved, whether those risks are known or unknown.

You release the A-Leagues, its employees, contractors and volunteers from any damage, loss, injury or liability ("Loss") you or your child may suffer in connection with participating in the event to the extent permitted by law, and where such Loss is not a direct result of the A-Leagues materially breaching these terms and conditions, acting in a grossly negligent manner or committing fraud or a wrongful act or omission. The A-Leagues expressly excludes, to the extent permitted by law, any liability for Loss to you or your child for acts or omissions of the Club and its employees, contractors and volunteers arising out of or in relation to the Program, save for an act or omission of the Club that is grossly negligent.

1.10 Liability of personal items

A-Leagues accepts no responsibility for personal items that are lost during Girls Unite Gala. A-Leagues reserve the right to discard any unclaimed items after 10 business days.

1.11 Code of Conduct

By participating in the event, you and your child agree to abide by any Code of Conduct they may be published from time to time ("the Code"). You acknowledge that serious or ongoing breaches of the Code are not tolerated and that those who breach the Code (and their child) risk being asked to leave sessions and/or being prohibited from attending future sessions, and/or having their child's registration in the event terminated. If you or your child is prohibited from attending future sessions or the event or your child's registration in the Program is terminated for a breach of the Code, you will not be eligible for a refund.

You understand that if you do not, or your child does not, follow the reasonable instructions of event staff, your child may be excluded from the event. If you or your child is excluded from the event for not following the reasonable instructions of staff, you will not be eligible for a refund.
